

## **HAITI RELIEF UPDATE**

### **JACMEL**

The lease on the property in Jacmel has been finalized. The 4 ½ acre property has been secured for 18 months with an additional 18 month option. We are in the process of moving all the equipment on the West Coast to CC Costa Mesa for crating prior to shipping it to CC Fort Lauderdale. Within the next week we will procure and then ship fencing to Jacmel. The fencing will be used to secure the property prior to moving structures and equipment onto the property.

CC Fort Lauderdale has leased a home in Jacmel and has already sent two relief teams to Haiti. The teams have been very busy helping out in the medical clinics and schools. They have also helped with food distribution as well as building homes and clinics. Each of the groups has also been active in ministry outreach throughout the Jacmel community.

Chet Lowe from CCFL has called meetings with the local pastors and has attended UN meetings. They, along with the mayor's office in Jacmel, are aware of our commitment to serve the community of Jacmel and are very supportive of our support. CCFL hopes to use the house to continue to deploy teams until the camp is operational.

Rainy season is several months out, but local officials are already very concerned about the impact it may have on the current situation.
